Personal Appearance & Safety Clothing

The Company expects Retail Associates to present themselves with a neat and clean appearance. We want to present a professional image.

The Company expects all Retail Associates who work directly with customers to wear a uniformed shirt or a customized name badge.

No Retail Associate may wear clothing with language or images that violate the Company's Harassment Prevention policy.

Additionally, the Company's Dress Code for all Retail Associates is as follows:

- No tank tops, camis, midriffs, or low-cut shirts may be worn at any time (no shoulders may be showing). Wide width sleeveless tops are acceptable.
- No open-toed shoes (stores or warehouse processing) unless shoe waiver has been signed.
- Leggings are allowed but only if the Retail Associate's shirt is knee length.
- No jeans or pants may be worn with holes or tears.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses may be worn, but must not be above 2 inches from the knee.
- Safety glasses must be worn anytime a Retail Associate operates a power tool.
